A former vice president at The Ford Foundation, McCarthy is an accomplished housing economist who focuses on social justice through land-use policy around the world. This IForum conversation was sparked by the United Way of Connecticut findings that the "survival budget" for Asset Limited Income Constrained Employed (ALICE) individuals and families is burdened by major unavoidable costs: childcare, transportation and housing.

Major employers, business leaders and policymakers are now learning that 1 of every 3 Connecticut households is an ALICE household. McCarthy and expert panelists will explore the difficult, and sometimes impossible, choices ALICE households face every day and the public- and private-sector solutions that can lessen their burden and help them find opportunity and secure places in Connecticut's labor force.
