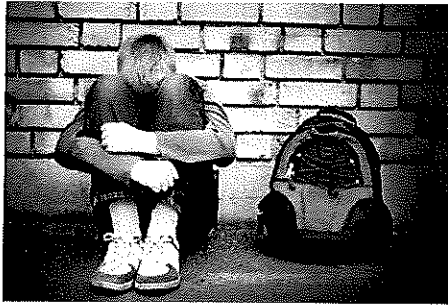


2ND ANNUAL CARDBOARD COMMUNITY

 - Donate for the event (food, shelter materials, water bottles, hygiene products)

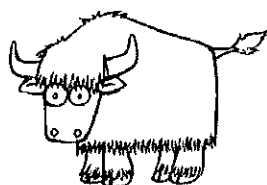
